Caulfield has a very rare tramway intersection. The corner of Balaclava and Hawthorn Rds (Balaclava Junction) is the only tramway 'Grand Union Junction' in the Southern Hemisphere. This means that trams may use the intersection crosswise and round each corner. Incidently, the first electric tram ran in Caulfield in 1913.

#### CRAIGELLACHIE.

'The Age' of Sept. 25th features the sale of the historic property known as 'Craigellachie' near the corner of Inkerman & Orrong Rds. This building dates from about 1864 and was the main feature of our first Newsletter (No.1) back in 1972.
